What is heat stress?

Heat stress occurs when cows can't get rid of the heat they create or can't stop absorbing heat from the environment.

Alert 75 - 78 degrees F Danger 79 - 83 degrees F Emergency > 83 degrees F

Intake of feed Intake of water


Normal 90 breaths/min Alert 90 - 110 breaths/min Danger 110 - 130 breaths/min Emergency > 130 breaths/min BCS & rate of gain
