➤ ANIMAL PURCHASE	
Amphibians/Pocket Pets/Snakes/Reptiles	Purchase of any amphibian(s)/pocket pet(s)/snake(s)/reptile(s)
Beef	Purchase of any beef animal(s) for 4-H project animal
Cavy	Purchase of any cavy(ies) for 4-H project animal
Dairy Cattle	Purchase of any dairy animal(s) for 4-H project animal
Dairy Goat	Purchase of any dairy goat(s) for 4-H project animal
Dog/Cat	Purchase/Lease of any dog(s)/cat(s) for 4-H project animal
Horse	Purchase of any horse(s) for 4-H project animal
Market Goat	Purchase of any goat(s) for 4-H project animal
Poultry	Purchase of any chicken/fowl for 4-H project animal
Pygmy Goat	Purchase of any pygmy goat(s) for 4-H project animal
Rabbit	Purchase of any rabbit(s) for 4-H project animal
Sheep	Purchase of any lamb(s) for 4-H project animal
Swine	Purchase of any pig(s) for 4-H project animal
➤ FEES/REGISTRATIONS	
4-H Member Fees	Fees may range from \$15 Arizona 4-H membership fee to any amount determined by club
Arizona Dept. Agriculture/Equine Hauling Pass	Arizona Department of Agriculture and Equine Hauling passes
Adoption	Adoption fees for project animals
Boarding	Facility fees (separate boarding from other fees, ie: feed, training, etc.)
Breeding Fee	Any applicable breeding stock fees
County Fair Commission Fee (6%)	Auction fees (automatically calculated if not entered)
Entry Fees/Parking/Passes	Show entry fees, parking passes, exhibitor passes (not County/State Fair)
County/State Fair Fees	Entry fees, parking passes, exhibitor/family passes, RV rental/space, etc.
Horse Lease	Lease fees for horse project animal(s)
Licensing	City licenses for dogs, pets
Membership	Any membership associated with project excluding 4-H (SAILA, Breed Associations, Arena/Club membership)
Animal Sitting Fee	Fees paid to others for watching project animals or facilities while away
Sale Fees	Fees for selling any project excluding county/state fair/ANLS project animal sales
Subscription	Fees paid for magazine, breed journal subscriptions, etc.
➤ SUPPLIES/EQUIPMENT	
4-H Supplies	Includes patches, ties, scarves, record book covers, jewelry, etc.
Ammunition	Fire arm and archery shooting sports supplies
Buyer Gift	Products purchased for livestock/small stock auction buyers
Clothing/Shoes/Hat/Costumes	Clothing, shoes/boots, hat, vests, costumes, etc. for project showmanship/exhibition
Equipment	Any equipment not related to showing (ie: tractor)
Feeder/Buckets/Waterer	Any feeders, buckets, waterers, for use with show project animals
Marketing	Materials purchased to market 4-H project (ie: paper, stamps, artwork for buyers, banners, pen signs, etc.)
Riding Equipment	Purchase of any materials required for riding horse project animals
Show Equipment/Supplies	Any equipment/supplies purchased for showing/exhibiting 4-H project(s)
Toys	Any purchases for project animal toys
➤ NUTRITION	
Animal Treats	Food treats for project animals
Feed	Grain, feed mixes (not supplements)
Forages	Hay/silage/other forages for project animals
Supplements	Any feed, medical supplements for project animals

Expenses	Description
➤ FACILITIES	
Building Materials	Materials purchased for project animals housing, stalls, fencing, wood, metal, block, etc.
Cage/Nest Box	Any housing for small project animals
Electrical	Materials for project animals (lamps, outlets, wiring, etc.)
Facilities	Barns, stalls, shade facilities
Fencing	Any wire, fence posts, wood, metal poles, etc. for fencing/arenas
Property Mortgage/Rent	Fees paid for property/buildings required to house/host project animal(s)
➤ SERVICES	
Chiropractor	Animal chiropractor fees
Dentist	Dental fees for project animals
Farrier	Shoeing fees
Grooming/Shearing/Trimming/Dehorning Services	Services required for project animals
Insurance	Insurance paid for vehicles and properties used in project & project animals
Meat Processing	Fees charged for carcass processing
Photo Processing	Fees paid to process photos
➤ TRANSPORTATION	
Delivery Fees	Fees for delivering purchased project animals; or fees paid for hauling project animals to events
Fuel	Gasoline for hauling animals to shows, members to meetings/events, etc.
Hotel/RV	Any fees for hotel, RV rental/ space rental stays excluding county and state fair for members
Trailer	Purchase or rental of trailer(s) used in hauling project animals
Truck	Purchase or rental of truck(s) used in hauling project animals
➤ EDUCATION	
Education	Fees for classes, workshops, online educational pursuits
Practice/Training/Lessons	Fees paid to trainers/educators
Quality Assurance	Fees paid to attend quality assurance training
➤ UTILITIES	
Electricity/Gas	Monthly utility fees for project animals
Water	Monthly utility fees for project animals
➤ HEALTH	
Medicine/Shots/Fly/Worming	Any medicine, shots, fly and worm eradication/control for project animals and facilities
Straw/Shavings/Litter/Bedding	Fees paid for project animal bedding
Surgery/Medical	Any fees associated with surgery/medical procedures related to project animals
Veterinarian	Any fees associated with veterinarian care for project animals

Income	Description
Auction Sales	Total sales from project animals sold through an event auction (County/State fair, ANLS, etc.)
Animal Sales	Total sales from project animals sold not through an event auction (private sales, etc.)
Breeding Fees	Income collected from utilizing project animal breeding fees
Equipment Sales	Income collected from sale of project related equipment (saddle, waterers, tack box, clothes, etc.)
House/Animal Care	Income collected from 4-H member caring for animals/property while others are away
Monies Won	Income derived from winnings at events (livestock shows, jackpots, etc.)
Product Sales	Income derived from sale of products related to 4-H project(s) (eggs, milk, wool, arts & crafts, photos, etc.)
Scholarships	Income derived from educational scholarships associated with 4-H project(s)
Skill Services	Income derived from performing skills/services associated with 4-H project(s) (Clipping, shearing, dehorning, trimming, clogging, photographing, DJ'ing, etc.)
