1. Approval of Previous Minutes

The minutes of the February 27, 2025 meeting were reviewed. Nathan Watkins moved to approve the minutes; Alan Seitz seconded. Motion carried.

2. Extension Operations - Carol Holden

a. Sierra Vista Location Updates

- There have been challenges with room assignments at Groth Hall (Rooms 503/506).
 Currently, the two offices are being consolidated into Room 506, with Room 503 remaining as a dedicated classroom/meeting space.
- An agreement with the UA South Foundation will cover six months; after 12/31/2025, occupancy will be month-to-month.
- Estimated savings with the new setup: \$8K/year plus utilities, compared to \$22– 24K/year previously.
- Budget requests have been sent to Cochise County; Board members are open to attending a County Supervisors' work session.
- The Discovery Gardens Facility Use Agreement has been extended for one year.

b. Personnel Updates

- **Horticulture Agent:** Hiring is paused due to visa uncertainties; considering possible reclassification to staff position.
- Water Wise Agent: Applications being accepted; based in Willcox.
- FCHS Agent: Position will post after July 1, 2025.
- Range Monitoring: Two final candidates remain for interviews.

c. New Hires

- **Jennifer Bell:** 4-H Assistant; experienced with 4-H and FFA, she is one month in the role and is doing great.
- **Savanna McReynolds:** ½-time Administrative Support; prior AmeriCorps experience.

3. Advisory Board Terms Expiring 06/30/2025

- Ron Bemis: Renewed term, will expire 06/30/2027.
- Aaron Cardona: Withdrawn; feels input is not utilized by Extension.
- Amber Morin: Absent; will be contacted.
- Nathan Watkins: Declined; retiring after 28 years of service.
- **Jason Zibart:** Willing to continue, excluding Chair or Vice Chair responsibilities will expire 06/30/2027.

4. Chair/Vice Chair Elections

- Chair: Ron Bemis nominated Moiria White; Alan Seitz seconded. No opposition.
 Moiria White elected Chair.
- Vice Chair: Alan Seitz nominated Ron Bemis; Nathan Watkins seconded. No opposition. Ron Bemis elected Vice Chair.

5. Financial Outlook FY26 - Connie Forsyth

- Current positions are secure; FY26 includes salary increases for eligible faculty and staff.
- County appropriation decisions are pending; the majority of funds support staff salaries.

- Jason Zibart: Community health updates; support for SNAP and fresh vegetable programs.
- Aaron Cardona: AMA updates; capital investment and produce contract concerns.

- Rhegan Derfus: Mobile farmers market, leadership academy, SNAP/EFNEP funding concerns due to Big Beautiful Bill.
