JUDGING CONTEST (

4-H livestock, smallstock, and poultry judging is an educational and competition a participants' ability to evaluate and rank animals based on specific criteria. The purpose help young people develop skills in animal husbandry, critical thinking, decision-making, and public speaking. Participants are given the opportunity to assess the quality and characteristics of different animals based on specific criteria and then present their reasoning.

Contest: Livestock Judging

Divisions:

- Contestants may compete as individuals or on a team:
 - o Seniors (14-18)
 - o Juniors (8-13)
 - o The oldest member of the team will determine the classification of the team.
 - o Team scores will consist of the combined scores of top 3 highest scores.

Format:

- The contest will consist of a total six (6) classes.
- Each class will consist of four animals.
- Ten (10) minutes are allowed to place animals in each class.
- Scores are given on placings and oral reasons.
- Oral reasons will be given by each individual. Seniors two (2) classes of reasons, Juniors one (1) set of reasons.

Attire:

REQUIRED: dress appropriately in English or Western attire.

For Western: jeans, boots, long sleeve shirts(tucked in), belt and western hat(or helmet) For English: English boots, jodhpurs, English shirt(tucked in), belt, jacket, and helmet. FFA Field dress (boots or closed shoes only); skirts are allowed but not recommended. Judging is Open to all 4-H and FFA members.

Contest: Horse Judging

Divisions:

- Contestants compete as individuals:
 - o Seniors (14-18)

- o Juniors (8-13)
- This is a qualifying contest for Seniors to compete in the Horse Judging contest at WNR in January. The top 4 places will qualify 5' place will serve as alternate.

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Format:

- The contest will consist of a total four (4) classes.
- Each class will consist of four animals.
- Maximum of fifteen (15) minutes are allowed to place animals in each class.
- Scores are given on placings and oral reasons.
- Oral reasons will be given by each individual. Two (2) classes of reasons, one halter and one performance.

Contest: Smallstock Judging

Divisions:

- Contestants will compete as individuals:
 - o Seniors (14-18)
 - o Juniors (8-13)

- Ten (10) minutes are allowed to place animals in each class.
- Scores are given on placings and oral reasons.
- Oral reasons will be given by each individual. Both Seniors and Juniors will give one set of reasons.

Contest: Poultry Judging

Divisions:

- Contestants will compete as individuals only open to Seniors (14-18).

- This is a qualifying contest to compete in the Poultry Judging contest at NAILE in November. The top 4 places will qualify.

Format:

- The contest will consist of a total six (6) classes. (May include following classes: Poultry Breed, Exterior Egg, Candling, Broken Out Egg, Meat ID, Ready to Cook).
- Ten (10) minutes are allowed to place each class.
- Scores are given on placings and oral reasons.
- Oral reasons will be given by each individual. Seniors will give one set of reasons.
