# SKILL-A-THON CONTEST



# **DESCRIPTION:**

Our Skill-a-thon Competition is an educational and competitive event that tests a participants' ability to identify and answer questions about livestock. This contest promotes learning, fosters a deeper understanding of the industry, and encourages hands-on experiences related to caring for and showcasing livestock at agricultural events. Participants will be given a written exam consisting of questions related to animal health, nutrition, breeding, and management. In addition, there will be rotations where participants must identify various aspects of livestock and agricultural items.

- 1. Each member will compete as an individual, no teams will be allowed.
- 2. Skill-a-thon classes will consist of two animal divisions. Each class will be further divided into age divisions. The classes will consist of :
  - Large Livestock (Beef, Swine, Lamb and Goat)
  - Small Livestock (Poultry, Rabbit, Cavy, and Pygmy Goat)
- 3. Age Divisions will follow the Arizona 4-H age divisions and are based on the age as of January 1, 2025.
  - Junior 8-10 Years Old
  - Intermediate 11-13 Years Old
  - Senior 14+ Years Old

### **CONTEST FORMAT:**

- Each class and age division will complete 4 stations and a written quiz.
- Stations may include:
  - o Large Livestock Breeds, Equipment, Anatomy, Feed, Meat Cuts, Wool Judging, Hay judging, Quality Assurance, Reproduction, and Marketing/Management
  - o Small Stock Breeds, Health, Anatomy, Colors and Markings, Feed, Quality Assurance, Body Types, Meat Cuts, and Equipment
- Each contestant will be given a score sheet based on their age division. Score sheets will include a list of possible answers for each station.
  - o Juniors will identify or answer numbers 1-10
  - o Intermediates will identify or answer numbers 1-15
  - o Seniors will identify or answer numbers 1-20
- Once the stations have been completed, each contestant will be given a written quiz based on their age division.
- Stations and guiz scores will be combined to determine the total score.

## **GENERAL RULES:**

- Only contestants and contest officials are permitted in the Skill-a-thon contest area during the competition.
- Contestants cannot confer with each other or their coach at any time during the contest.
- Questions must be directed to Contest Officials only.
- Contest Officials can help with reading aloud if needed.
- Contestants are not allowed to have cell phones or electronic devices on their person during the contest.
- Contestants are encouraged to wear close-toed shoes/boots for safety.
- Contestants are not to pick up or touch any item that is being identified or evaluated, unless otherwise directed by contest officials.
- Rule violations will cause disqualification.

# SCORING:

- Highest total score overall wins.
- The records tabulated and submitted by the Judge shall be final, once they have been publicly announced.
