The Master Gardener in-person course will be offered Thursday evenings starting January 9, 2025 from 6:00pm to 9:00pm at the University of Arizona, Cooperative, Extension, Pinal County Conference Room, 820 East Cottonwood Lane, #C, Casa Grande, AZ 85122.

Registration is required. The course will be completed over 15 weeks of instruction. The cost of the course is \$200 plus the purchase of the Arizona Master Gardener Manual (\$55).
