HERDSMANSHIP AWARD SCORING

HERDSMANSHIP: Each Club exhibiting livestock shall name one member, or more, if necessary, to be always on duty during the day, except when showing. The Herdsman's duty will be to assist in keeping all livestock exhibits of their Club neatly be displayed at all times, also to answer questions and to extend courtesy to the public. This is to ensure proper care for more than one animal, as well as train 4-H/FFA members to handle and care for more than one animal. Score card for judging Herdsmanship will be as follows:

SEPARATE AWARDS: Will be presented for Herdsmanship in: Beef, Livestock and Small Animals. Awards will be presented at the Exhibitor Meeting on Sunday. First Place in each will receive \$50.00.

HERDSMANSHIP JUDGING: Thursday 10:00 AM - 7:00 PM; Friday 10:00 AM - 7:00 PM; Saturday 10:00 AM - 5:00 PM. **Displays must be left in place until 10:00 AM on Sunday.** Livestock will be stalled by Clubs, except for Beef & Breeding Beef: with Clubs grouped within species. Small Animals and Companion Animals will be grouped by clubs.

DAILY GAIN AWARDS

Awards for daily gain will be awarded in the Beef, Sheep, Swine and Goat divisions. Calculations will be determined by taking the difference between the official beginning weight and official ending weight and dividing by the official number of days on feed. Only Animals shown in a Market Class are eligible for Daily Gain Awards.

- Lot 1 Senior Livestock Judging
- Lot 2 Intermediate Livestock Judging
- Lot 3 Junior Livestock Judging
- Lot 4 Team of Four, from same Club or Chapter

Criteria for selecting team Members for AZ Nationals will be as follows:

- 1. Members must attend 75% of County Livestock Judging Events.
- Scores for each judging will be totaled and divided by the total points possible to give a grand score for each Member.
- The top twelve (12) Members will make up the three (3) teams from Mohave County.

Exhibitors should use the following GUIDELINES in determining appropriate dress for Judging, Showmanship Events, and Livestock Auction; dark pants, long-sleeved shirt and non-cloth, close-toed shoes, and belt. Members involved with livestock MUST have long pants and long-sleeved shirt and hard sole, close-toed shoes and belt.
