OWNERSHIP DEADLINES: All Small Animal exhibits must be owned by the Exhibitor no later than May 31, 2023.

STEWER/ROASTER ANIMAL REGISTRATION, PROOF of OWNERSHIP, and YQCA must be on file with MCYLA. Ownership deadlines do not apply to Rabbit Meat Pens, Fryers or Roasters born after May 31; however, mother of Meat Pen must be owned by the deadline. Exhibitors MUST be the PRIMARY care giver (including feeding, cleaning & training of Animal) by the OWNERSHIP DEADLINE. Display cages will be provided, but feeding, cleaning and general care are the responsibility of the Exhibitor.

Only exhibits to be judged may be brought to the Fair. Each Exhibitor must bring their own exhibit to Judging Class except in unusual circumstances, such as sickness, family emergency, conflict in Livestock schedule, or having more than one entry in a Class. Extra-curricular activities **will not be considered as an exception**. Each Exhibitor must use his/her own exhibit in the Showmanship competition and said exhibit must be entered in Conformation Classes in the Fair for judging. All Exhibitors and their assistants in the show ring MUST be in show dress (see # 10).

All breeds accepted by the American Rabbit Breeders Association, American Poultry Association, and the National Pigeon Association, as stated in the Standard of Perfection, may be exhibited by 4-H/FFA Small Stock Exhibitors. **Two entries per Breed per Variety per Lot in Classes 3 through 52, 56 through 68, 72, 76 through 88, 95-101.** One entry per Lot in Market, Showmanship and Pet Classes.

RABBITS AND CAVY

Rabbits must have been tattooed in the left ear and correspond to entry form. Cavy must be ear-tagged in the left ear and correspond to the entry form. NO SUBSTITUTION WILL BE ALLOWED.

POULTRY AND PIGEON

Exhibits must have been banded and numbers to correspond to entry form. NO SUBSTITUTION WILL BE ALLOWED.

PET CLASSES

Open to first-year members only (in a particular project) who do not have any other entry and whose entry does not fit any breed classification. Each breed will be judged separately.

AWARDS

Where there is no competition, Judge(s) may award one ribbon or no ribbon according to merit. Danish system of ribbons of Blue, Red, and White will be awarded. Rosettes and trophies will only be awarded if exhibit merits such award.

MEAT CLASSES

Meat Pens should show the 4-H/FFA Member's ability to produce high-quality meat types for commercial production. The time required varies with each project. Exhibitors are limited to one entry in each Meat Lot. Only animals that are entered in a Meat Class may be sold at the Mohave County Youth Livestock Auction. To participate in Market Class and qualify for Mohave County Youth Livestock Auction, Exhibitor must also enter and participate in the Showmanship Class in the same project. No Market animals can be entered into a Breeding Class.

Commercial Type rabbits, as defined by the American Rabbit Breeders Association, will be accepted. **Lot 1, 2 and 3 are products of Member owned Breeding Does. Breeding Doe must be owned by May 31. Open only to breeds recognized as breeds with mature ideal weight over 8 lbs., excluding "Giant Breeds" as listed in the ARBA, Standards of Perfection Book**

- Lot 1 Rabbit Meat Pen: Fryers, 3 rabbits; 3½ lbs. to 5½ lbs. each
Official Tagging Aug 19
Three (3) fryers: should be uniform in size and weight.
Fryers must have permanent tattoo mark and must be recorded on entry form. Fryers must be pure breed. Age limit not over 10 weeks old.
- Lot 2 Fryer: 1 rabbit; 3½ lbs. to 5½ lbs.
Official Tagging Aug 19

Fryers must be pure breed. Age limit not over 10 weeks old. Fryers may not be a part of a Meat Pen

- Lot 3 Roasters: 10 weeks to 6 months old; 5½ lbs. to 9 lbs.

Official Tagging Aug 19

Rabbits may be purchased but must be 8 weeks old and in members possession by May 31.

- Lot 4 Stewer: 6 to 12 months of age (born between September 14, 2022, and March 13, 2023); min weight of 8 lbs. Ownership deadline for these animals is May 31.
