- Shooting Sports / 4-H Tri-fold creation: **No action in the last 60 days.**
- 2023 State Match Planning: Please see attached In Progress Review (IPR) tracking document for detailed update.
- Winter 2022 Level-1 Training (18-20 NOV 22) AAR. Complete survey sent out with meeting agenda.
 - 11 respondents to survey
 - Two to one preference of completing general modules 1-4 online, prior to in-person instruction beginning
 - Very favorable comments on the quality, depth and knowledge of our discipline instructors
 - Strong majority prefer multiple discipline training opportunities over the weekend at the cost of depth IOT offer more projects to their club members
 - Split responses on digital versus hardcopy reference books
 - Less than favorable responses on host range facility personnel interactions

Brief discussion about the importance of having hard copy references available for level 1 instructors of specific lesson plans and range commands, should a softcopy only lesson binder plan be attempted.

- State equipment inventory central consolidation: State equipment holding room at Tucson Ag Center 50% cleaned up. Inventory of remaining equipment has not begun yet.
- Level-2 Training Update: May 1-5, 2023, in Kansas at the Rock Springs 4-H Center. Registration information has not been released as of 22 DEC 22. We will be sending no less than one instructor for archery and one for western heritage. Intent is to send four to five total instructors depending on instructor and funds availability.
- AZ 4-H Level 1 and 2 Instructor certification records review in progress.
