- 2023-2024 State Multi Discipline Championship Match, 27-29 OCT 2023 coordination.
 - Flagstaff Range Complex highly likely to be the location once confirmed from their board and a recon visit by Erik and Doug. Questions about range capacity and use of steel targets need to be addressed.
 - Discussed using a county task organization model to gather preliminary discipline participation priorities from project members, as well as to confirm instructor sign off of their participation. Erik will assemble a request to send to the counties with a suspense of NLT 31 JUL 2023 to submit their numbers.
 - Discussed the desire to expand competition course of fire depth for senior competitors. Have to contend with available time in order to do so, but interest is there.
 - Discussed concept of using county staff to consolidate all county entries to State Championships.
 - All discipline rule modifications are due to Erik prior to the next State Committee in July.
