### - Old Business:

 AZ Shooting Sports Operations Policy update. State Director (Dr. Todd Kessner) has been briefed on the issues and has begun trying to work on this one through the administration.

- Shooting Sports / 4-H Tri-fold creation: U of A marketing department working on a background draft. Expected return is on or about 15 April.
- 2024 State pins design and order. (Thank you, Kat, for gathering the following information!)
  - 3/4" vs. 1" pins size
    - Vendor: National Custom Insignia, Inc. (last year's company)
    - $\frac{3}{4}$ " cost \$1.03 each plus tax (30 kids x 50 pins = \$1669)
    - 1.5" cost \$1.42 each plus tax (30 kids x 50 pins = \$2300)
    - 5-week delivery time
  - Quantity and size needed? <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" size will be ordered, Doug has 300 on hand
- 2024 State Team Commitments. Total of 27 kids as of 01 April 2024.
  - Air pistol: 3, one pull out (coach = Jon)
  - Air rifle: 1 (coach = Carol)
  - Archery compound: 4+1 (coach = Kip)
  - Archery recurve: 1 (Ryan)
  - Hunting Skills: 4 (coach = Mary and Steve)
  - Muzzleloader: 4 (coach = Doug and John)
  - Shotgun: 2, one pull out (coach = Stacy)
  - Smallbore pistol: 4 (coach = Derek)
  - Smallbore rifle: 4, one wildcard addition (coach = Jarred and Erik)
- 2025 State Rules Modifications Recommended: Rules final discussion tabled until next month.
  - Process needed to deal with protests and issues that may arise after a course of fire is complete, but before awards presentation has occurred; or a definitive time period that protests are no longer accepted.
  - Authorization is needed for event operations staff to spot check scores and make changes if needed, in order to avoid potential purposeful scheming or accidental scoring errors.
  - Allowable assistance from another 4-H member, volunteer, or RSO during written tests.
  - Allowable smallbore rifle trigger weight for Sr. class in 3-P match.
  - 2024 State Air Championships Match Update and IPR. Volunteer list:

- State Shooting Team sponsor update.
  - (2) \$2k sleeves, (2) \$1K silver logo slots, (6) \$350 copper slots remain available as of 01 April 2024.
  - Recommend each team member contribute \$50 for registration.
     Discussion followed. Committee recommendation to charge each competitor \$100 via Z-Suites.
- Midway Coaching/Instructor grant. We have not received any word back yet on the status of our proposal as of 01 April 2024.
- Open-up the October Sr. Tryout Match to all ages (fun/invitational or ???); provide more opportunities to compete with resources that are already in place. Match will be opened up to all ages.
- MAY 11-12 Hunting Skills and Western Heritage Level-1 Instructor Training Workshop is a "go". Registration is open in Z-Suites now. The location is James 4-H Camp. The cost is \$200 per person including room and board.
