- Old Business:
 - AZ Shooting Sports Operations Policy update. State Director (Dr. Todd Kessner) has been briefed on the issues and has begun trying to work on this one through the administration.
 - Shooting Sports / 4-H Tri-fold creation: U of A marketing department working on a background draft. Expected return is unknown.

-

- 2025 State Rulebook recommended changes for discussion and decision follow. Final rulebook modifications will be made after discussion during the August 2024 SSSC meeting.
 - Process needed to deal with protests and issues that may arise after a course of fire is complete, but before an awards presentation has occurred; or a definitive time period that protests are no longer accepted.
 - Authorization is needed for event operations staff to spot check scores and make changes if needed, in order to avoid potential purposeful scheming or accidental scoring errors.
 - Allowable assistance from another 4-H member, volunteer, or RSO during written tests.
 - Allowable smallbore rifle trigger weight for Sr. class in 3-P match.
 - Add National 4-H CMP rules to state rulebook for county use.
 - State Archery 3-D Fun Shoot 27-28 July 2024. Location is Camp Navajo, east of Flagstaff. The flyer for the event is up on our website and registration is open!
 - 2024-2025 State Shooting Sports Ambassador Nominations. Only one packet was received for our deputy ambassador position. Pima county's Daisy Johnson was selected.
 - Volunteer and family shooting sports surveys were sent out to state shooting team members and their families. Twelve responses have been submitted to date. Large scale roll out expected within the next 45 days.
 - AZ SSS Midway Endowment account first withdrawal requested 01 June 2024. \$300 (5%) will be disbursed from the account and immediately returned in order to receive matching funds from the Potterfields.

 - o 2024 National Championships after action review discussion.
- Coach financial support needed, especially for those that do not have children participating. County and State support options. Tiered levels?

- Need for a written contract/commitment for use to communicate member and coach expectations. Inclusion of a deposit or held check?
- Use of "Whats-Ap" to communicate with all families.

- Eliminate use of cutlines for Nationals qualification.
- Get the team together before Nationals, close to the qualifier?
- Need more volunteers to make more events happen.

- Create a club award at our state competition for "complete" discipline teams?
