Incidental Speaker Volunteer (ISV): A person who either a) works with young people in the presence of a certified volunteer and/or an Extension Employee or b) share time and expertise and provides services working with other volunteers and/or Extension Personnel.

A person serving as a resource volunteer will be covered by the liability insurance provided by The University of Arizona ONLY while participating in this sanctioned 4-H Youth Development event/activity.

**Responsibilities:**

- Work cooperatively with Community Club Leaders, Project Leaders and/or Pinal County 4-H Youth Development Professional
- Serve as a telephone resource in project/program area
- Keep up-to-date in project/program area
- Serve as a positive role model for youth
- Possibly teach a special project
- Time Commitment– varies with specific project, special program, and time of year

- Liability insurance for official 4-H activities/events
- Leadership training opportunities
- Leadership recognition
- Opportunities to meet and share ideas with other leaders
- Contribution as a positive youth development volunteer

- Interest in sharing knowledge and special subject matter with others
- Ability to relate well and communicate with a wide variety of people
- Willingness to work with any 4-H member, leader or staff
- Knowledge of special project area and willingness to update skills
- Enthusiasm
- Enjoy working with people and youth
