## RESOURCES & ACTIVITIES

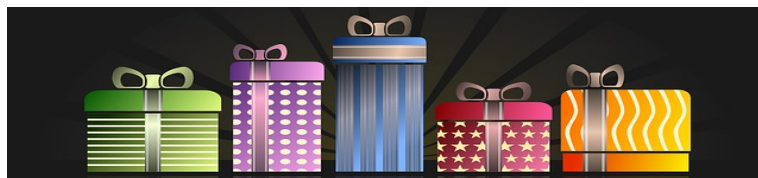

## CREATE YOUR CORNER

### ACTIVITY IDEAS

#### House and Homes

- Show pictures of different types of homes.
- Discuss how we all help to keep a home clean and well organized.
- Make a picture collection of different kinds of houses.

#### Clean Sweep

- Learn how to prepare a cleaning kit.

#### Color

- Make a color wheel.
- Make a Finger Paint picture.
- Do the Fold, Dip and Dry activity with paper towels, coffee filters, rice or tissue paper.
- Make a Torn Tissue Design.
- Make Crayon Melt prints.
- Make a Crayon Sandwich.
- Learn about Cool colors and Warm colors.

#### Shapes

- Discuss different types of shapes - Geometric and irregular.
- Arrangement of shapes.
- Make a Dough Art project.
