# **VOLUNTEER FAQs**

#### What can be done as a volunteer service?

The volunteerism must be directly related to the Horse Project and/or 4-H Horse Events. Attached you will find a partial list of jobs and ideas.

#### Where do I perform the volunteer hours?

You may volunteer at an event. Be sure to have your Horse Passport stamped at the event by Troy or Jimi.

### Who must perform the volunteer hours?

The 4-H member, another family member, a neighbor, a friend, anyone with an interest in the member. Example: If your grandma comes to visit and goes to the show, she can perform a job at the show and count it as the member's volunteer time.

### When do the volunteer hours need to be complete?

You must complete your hours and have them recorded in your Horse passport when you submit your record book at the end of the year.

#### How do I report my volunteer hours?

Complete the Horse Passport at each event, have it stamped by Troy or Jimi.
