- Respect other 4-H families' property and privacy rights.
- Refrain from physical or verbal abuse.
- Abstain from approaching Judges, Ring Stewards, and Show personnel during the show.
- Apply safety concepts to individuals, groups and property.
- Accept personal responsibility for behavior.
- Make sure horses are being treated humanely at all times.

By signing this Parental Code of Conduct, I acknowledge that the Pinal County 4-H Horse Program is endorsing a safe, peaceful and enjoyable show experience for its youth members, volunteers and parents. Any violation of bulleted items listed above may result in consequences to the 4-H exhibitor, including disqualification from show classes and parent(s) removal from the horse show where the dispute arose. The Pinal County Horse Advisory Committee Grievance Committee will make final decisions on violations during the 4-H event.
