## Positive Youth Development

4-H and FFA youth have been working hard on their projects, gaining knowledge and skills to help make their projects a success! In addition to their meetings, practice, record keeping, community volunteering and their personal dedication to their projects, they have been networking with the community to bring awareness and attract support for the 4-H/FFA EXPO Show & Auction. At the Show and Auction, they will demonstrate their knowledge and skills to the Judge in their respective fields. The Judge will confirm the quality and conformation of the project as well as their ability to present and handle their animal. Then, at Auction, these young businessmen and women have the brief opportunity to present themselves and sell their projects, noting that the sale of their project will hopefully represent success and their ability to return the following year to continue in their positive youth development.

Market Animals being sold may include swine, steers, lambs, goats, chickens, rabbits, and turkeys. Buying an animal is a great way for you to purchase a quality product AND support the 4-H/FFA members of Yavapai County.

All EXPO Livestock Exhibitors are required to complete and become certified in Livestock Quality assurance. This training develops knowledge and skills pertaining to ethics, health and food safety regarding raising animals intended for consumption, assuring the customer the best possible product.

Other projects being auctioned may include homemade quilts, handcrafted leather items and more. Food and other items will be available in the silent auction.

Please support what these young people are doing and visit EXPO all week long; take a walk through the exhibits, watch the shows and competitions and join us Saturday for a delicious free BBQ Lunch and attend the Auction!

4-H and FFA members are the future! Your purchase of an animal or a project supports a young person who is experiencing business on a small scale and we sincerely appreciate YOU be a part of it!

### PURCHASE OPTIONS

#### **\* CASH \* CHECK \* CREDIT CARD \***

Payment at time of purchase is required, unless prior arrangements are made.

When you are a successful bidder a runner will come to you and have paperwork for you to sign. You will have three options:

1. **Choose a processor** - EXPO transports your animal for you!
2. **Live pick up** - May be Picked Up April 25<sup>th</sup> after 6:00pm
3. **Resale** - Buyer has the option to donate purchase back to EXPO for resale. The profits go back to the program to off-set costs of the venue, provide awards, and many 4H and FFA educational/individual scholarships.

Can't make it to EXPO but you want to bid on an animal? **Absentee bid** forms are available on-line or from an exhibitor.

### Add-On Donations

Can't afford to purchase a project? Add-on donations are a great way to encourage and support a young person and their hard work without purchasing the animal or item through the auction.

Forms are available from 4-H/FFA members, at our on-line website, or at one of our Extension Offices, and at the EXPO buyer sign in area.

### After Your Purchase

You can choose your processor from our list or use another of your choice. EXPO will transport your purchase(s) to any local processor you choose free of charge. The processor will contact you such that you may identify the custom cuts you and your family prefer. When your animal is done, they will call you to pick up your custom order. It will be cut, wrapped and frozen...don't forget to request dog bones!

The processing fee is not included in your bid price. Approx. prices are available at auction.
