Exhibitors during judging. The various skills, craftsmanship and designs will be the basis for evaluation on judging. Size of article will not be considered, unless applicable.

- C. Award is considered final when ribbon has been placed.
- 21. The Showmanship Contest will be judged on the Exhibitor's ability to show his/her animal to its advantage and his/her knowledge in handling, fitting, and selecting animals for production and show. The Judge may also ask questions pertaining to the project. Separate classes will be held for judging Junior and Senior Showmanship. No ribbons from Showmanship Contest will be displayed on person or animal during Conformation classes.
- 22. Other entries not listed in the Fair Book may be shown and judged by approval of the 4-H/FFA Fair Committee. (See Rule 7).

## PROTEST AND APPEAL

- 23. The 4-H/FFA Fair Committee will decide on any complaints or grievances that come about during the Mohave County Fair 4-H and FFA Division. CODE OF CONDUCT - All Exhibitors, Parents, and Leaders will conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner. DISCOURTESY or UNSPORTSMANLIKE conduct will NOT be tolerated.
- 24. All protests must be made to and filed with the 4-H/FFA Fair Committee within five (5) hours after the decision has been made. It being considered that a decision is made when the notation of the decision of the Committee or Judge is entered in the department record book.
- 25. All protests must be made in writing and must be accompanied by a deposit of \$10.00. Deposit will only be returned if protest is upheld. Protests must state plainly the cause of complaint or appeal, with specific charges and recital of the facts relied upon or the rule violated, naming witnesses and their addresses by whom proofs are to be made.
- 26. No protest or appeal based upon a statement that the Judge(s) is incompetent or have overlooked an animal or article will be considered by the 4-H/FFA Fair Committee, whose decision shall be final.

## **CLUB EXHIBITOR PARTICIPATION AWARD**

A Club Exhibitor Participation Award will be presented to the Club with the highest number of non-poster exhibits displayed in the Exhibit Building prorated by the number of non-Animal related project members officially enrolled in the club. A point value will be allotted for each exhibit; 3 Points, Blue Ribbon; 2 Points, Red Ribbon; 1 Point, White Ribbon. Total Points / # Members=Score

AWARDS: 1ST PLACE \$50.00; 2ND PLACE \$35.00; 3RD PLACE \$15.00

## **DEPARTMENT 500- CLUB EXHIBITS**

- 1. The Club Exhibit provides Members an opportunity to acquaint the public with a specific phase of their Club or Chapter Program. The exhibit can show what they have learned, the activities in which they have participated, or the contributions of their Club to the community. Judges will insist upon high quality of products and materials used in the exhibit. A high scoring exhibit will be artistically arranged, colorful and attractive.
- 2. Club exhibits shall be limited to one entry by a Club or Chapter.
- 3. Exhibit must be designed, constructed, and installed by Members.
- 4. Exhibitors must make arrangements to replace all fruit and vegetables which deteriorate during the Fair.
- 5. Moving parts or mechanical devices in the exhibits must be kept in operation during the entire time of the Fair.
- Clubs or Chapters wishing to compete must submit online entry by Entry Deadline.
