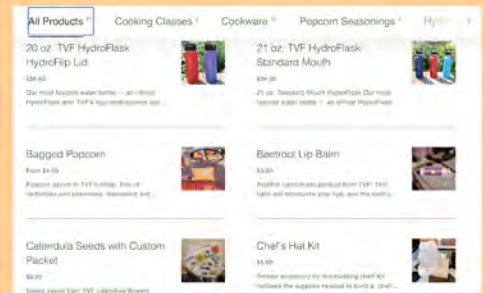


A few members of NWO helped an elderly couple with some yard work as a community service project! Great job!
