I understand that I will be expected to attend all training sessions and provide a minimum of fifty (50) hours of volunteer service within 13 months of course completion. I further understand that I will become a Certified Master Gardener when I complete both the training and the volunteer work. To maintain certification, I will commit at least 12 hours of volunteer service and 6 hours of continuing education annually. If I do not wish to become a certified Master Gardener volunteer, I understand that my course fee will be at a higher rate of \$325 and I will earn an Arizona Certificate of Home Horticulture.
