 - 4-H Project Leader -- Coordinate efforts in one project. (Name Project
 - 4-H Educational Activity Leader -- Coordinate educational activities of the club.
 - 4-H Community Service Activity Leader -- Coordinate community service activities of the club.
 - 4-H Social Activity Leader -- Coordinate the social activities of the club.
 - 4-H Fund-Raising Activity Leader -- Coordinate club fund-raising efforts.
 - 4-H Records Leader -- Instruct 4-H members, leaders, and parents in proper 4-H project record keeping procedures.
 - 4-H Club Advisory Committee Member -- Establishes the 4-H club and recruits the club leadership team and the youth membership and provides support and guidance to the leadership team.
 - 4-H Resource/Support Volunteer -- Share a specific skill or resource with the club on a short-term basis.

COUNTY

- 1. Provide a car for pooling transportation to county meetings when available.
- 2. Encourage my son/daughter to participate in county workshops, fairs, fashion shows, teen activities, etc.
- 3. Chaperone and/or provides transportation for county programs or camp.
