Animals deemed uncontrollable or a safety concern, as determined by meeting of MCYLA Committee, will not be permitted to show and must be immediately removed from the fairgrounds.

Nose rings may NOT be used.

No bulls or heifers will be allowed in the Mohave County Youth Livestock Auction, nor can they be shown in the Market Classes. All steers must have been dehorned with horns not longer than 1 inch above hairline.

### **CLASS 1 BEEF SHOWMANSHIP – Steers & Heifers ONLY**

- Lot 2 Intermediate Showmanship
- Lot 3 Junior Showmanship

Class may be divided into multiple classes, depending on number in class.

To participate in Market Class and qualify for Mohave County Youth Livestock Auction, Exhibitor must also enter and participate in the Showmanship Class in the same project. No Market animals can be entered into a Breeding Class. NO BULLS may be shown in Showmanship.

### **CLASS 2 MARKET STEER CONFORMATION**

Minimum weight at Fair: 950 lbs., no maximum.  
Pay limit: 1,350 lbs. Age limit at Fair: 24 months.

- Lot 2 Prospect Steer Class: 949 lbs and under

Members must know birth date of goat and freshening date, if applicable. If an exhibitor has more than one goat, they must be prepared with extra handlers (there will be a 2-minute gate call).

**ALL GOATS** must meet Arizona Department of Agriculture requirements.

**CLASS 1 GOAT SHOWMANSHIP**

- Lot 1 Senior Showmanship
- Lot 2 Intermediate Showmanship
- Lot 3 Junior Showmanship

Class may be divided into multiple classes, depending on number in class.

To participate in Market Class and qualify for Mohave County Youth Livestock Auction, Exhibitor must also enter and participate in the Showmanship Class in the same project. No Market animals can be entered into a Breeding Class. No BUCKS may be shown in Showmanship.

**CLASS 2 MARKET GOATS TO 12 MONTHS**

It is recommended goats be born no later than March 30, 2023.  
Goats will be aged and must not have permanent incisors.  
All Market Goats must have been dehorned with horns no longer than 1 inch above hairline.

Exhibitor may only show one per weight class.  
Minimum weight at Fair: 70 lbs.  
Open to Wethers and Does ONLY.

- Lot 1 Weight Lots:
  - Light: 70-79 lbs.
  - Medium: 80-89 lbs.
  - Heavy: 90 lbs. & up
- Lot 2 Prospect Class: UNDER 70 lbs.
  - Prospect classes are not Mohave County Youth Livestock Auction eligible.
  - Prospect classes are not eligible to receive Mohave County Goat Award.

**CLASS 3 MEAT BREED GOATS (Limit 3 in each Lot)**

Meat Breed goats may have horns IF their breed requires for breed standards.

- Lot 1 Kid Doe: 1 month to 12 months old

- Lot 3 Aged Doe: 2 years and over
- Lot 4 Kid Buck: 1 month to 12 months old
- Lot 5 Yearling Buck: 1 year to 2 years
- Lot 6 Aged Buck: 2 years and over
- Lot 7 Herd: 3 - 5 animals (Doe, Buck & Kid(s))  
Kid(s) may be entered as Market Goat.

**CLASS 4 DAIRY GOAT (Limit 3 in each Lot) (Ribbons Only)**

All Dairy goats must be dehorned as per ADGA rules.

Fleece must be shorn (except Wool Breed Class) prior to arrival at fairgrounds (exception for touch ups and final clipping).

**ALL SHEEP** must meet Arizona Department of Agriculture requirements.

### CLASS 1 SHEEP SHOWMANSHIP

- Lot 1 Senior Showmanship
- Lot 2 Intermediate Showmanship
- Lot 3 Junior Showmanship

Class may be divided into multiple classes, depending on number in class.

To participate in Market Class and qualify for Mohave County Youth Livestock Auction, Exhibitor must also enter and participate in the Showmanship Class in the same project. No Market animals can be entered into a Breeding Class. NO RAMS may be shown in Showmanship.

### CLASS 2 MARKET LAMB

It is recommended lambs be born around March. Suggested weight of lambs at the ownership deadline: approximately 60 lbs. depending on breed, but not mandatory.

Exhibitor may only show one per weight class.  
Minimum weight: 100 lbs; Pay limit: 150 lbs.  
Open to Ewes & Wethers ONLY.

- Lot 1 Weight Lots:
  - Light: 100-120 lbs.
  - Medium: 121-135 lbs.
  - Heavy: 136 lbs. & up
- Lot 2 Prospect Class: UNDER 100 lbs.
  - Prospect classes are not MCYLA eligible.
  - Prospect classes are not eligible to receive Mohave County Lamb Award.

- Lot 2 Yearling Ewe: 12 - 24 months old
- Lot 3 Aged Ewe: over 2 years old
- Lot 4 Lamb Ram: under 12 months old
- Lot 5 Yearling Ram: 12 - 24 months old
- Lot 6 Aged Ram: over 2 years old
- Lot 7 Produce of Ewe: one or more Market Lambs from ewe lambd by an ewe that has been shown previously as a 4-H or FFA project at the Mohave County Fair. Lambs may be owned by different Exhibitors.

**All swine must be watered with a self-contained nipple-type water device (NO OPEN WATER CONTAINERS, NO CONNECTING TO WATER LINES).**

All swine should be ear tagged. It is the objective of the Swine Program to feed, care for, and train pigs for show and sale. Members are to be able to handle their animals both in and out of the show ring.

**ALL SWINE** must meet Arizona Department of Agriculture requirements.

**CLASS 1 SWINE SHOWMANSHIP**

- Lot 1 Senior Showmanship
- Lot 2 Intermediate Showmanship
- Lot 3 Junior Showmanship

Class may be divided into multiple classes, depending on number in class.

To participate in Market Class and qualify for Mohave County Youth Livestock Auction, Exhibitor must also enter and participate in the Showmanship Class in the same project. No Market animals can be entered into a Breeding Class, with the exception on Class 3, Lot 4. NO BOARS may be shown in Showmanship.

**CLASS 2 MARKET SWINE (Barrows & Gilts ONLY)**

Exhibitor may only show one per weight class.

Pigs should be 60 - 80 lbs., suggested starting weight. Must not be born before February 1. Minimum weight at Fair: 215 lbs. NO max weight. Pay limit: 275 lbs.

## Lot 1 Weight Lots:

Light: 215-235 lbs.  
Medium: 236-260 lbs.  
Heavy: 261 lbs. & up

## Lot 2 Prospect Class: UNDER 215 lbs.

Prospect classes are not Mohave County Youth Livestock Auction eligible.  
Prospect classes are not eligible to receive Mohave County Swine Award.

- Lot 4 Product of sow: two (2) or more Market hogs from litters farrowed by a sow that has been shown previously as a 4-H or FFA project at the Mohave County Fair. Sow and weaner pigs may be owned by different Exhibitors. The owner of the sow will have the right to choose at Fair those hogs to be shown in this Lot.
