WEATHER UPDATE

A trough of low pressure passing through the Intermountain West will result in windy and much cooler conditions Monday. Winds will dissipate Tuesday, but temperatures will remain below normal through Wednesday. High pressure redevelops over Arizona late in the week, bringing a return to above normal temperatures. Some moisture will enter the state with this heat and may produce isolated afternoon and evening thunderstorms by the weekend.
