OWNERSHIP deadline for goats: No later than May 31, 2018

AN ANIMAL REGISTRATION FORM <u>must</u> be on file at the 4-H Office **no later than** 5 P.M. the business day following ownership deadline. Members MUST be the PRIMARY care giver (including feeding, cleaning & training of Animal) by the OWNERSHIP DEADLINE.

#### All Bucks must be removed from the fairgrounds after they are shown.

Any breed, cross-bred animals allowed. **Each goat must be tattooed or ear tagged.** All exhibitors responsible for feed, bedding, etc. Milk-out time for all milking does will be between 6:00 PM and 7:00 PM the night prior to the show day. Only healthy animals in show condition accepted. Members must know birth date of goat and freshening date, if applicable.

#### **CLASS 1 GOAT SHOWMANSHIP**

- Lot 1 Senior Showmanship
- Lot 2 Junior Showmanship

The exhibitor must show a market goat in the Showmanship Class unless the exhibitor only has breeding OR Pack goats at the Fair. In such case, the exhibitor will show a younger of the breeding or Pack animals. No Bucks may be shown in Showmanship.

#### **GOAT CLASSES**

#### CLASS 2 MARKET GOATS TO 12 MONTHS

Ownership deadline for market goats: **no later than** May 31, 2018. Born no later than March 30, 2018. Goats will be aged and must not have permanent incisors. All Market Goats must have been dehorned with spurs not longer than 1 inch above hairline. Minimum weight at Fair: 60 lbs. Open to Wethers and Does ONLY.

- Lot 1 Weight lots: light, medium and heavy, may be set by 4-H/FFA Fair Committee after all animals are weighed.
- Lot 2 Prospect Class: under 60 lbs Aug 1st Ownership Prospect classes are not Auction eligible.

All Dairy goats must be dehorned as per ADGA rules.

CLASS 3 DAIRY GOAT (Limit 3 in each Lot) (Ribbons Only)

- Lot 1 Junior Kid: up to 6 months old
- Lot 2 Kid: 6 to 12 months old.
- Lot 3 Yearling Doe: 1 year to 2 years (never freshened)
- Lot 4 Aged Doe over 2 years (never freshened)
- Lot 5 Dry Doe: any age (must have freshened at least once)
- Lot 5 Yearling Buck: 1 year to 2 years
- Lot 6 Aged Buck
- Lot 7 Herd: 3 to 5 animals (Doe, Buck & Kid(s)) Kids may be entered as Market Goat.

#### CLASS 4 DAIRY GOAT MILKERS (Limit 3 in each lot)

- Lot 1 First Year Milker: under 2 years old
- Lot 2 Second Year Milker: 2 years old and under 3 years old
- Lot 3 Third Year Milker: 3 years old and under 4 years old
- Lot 4 Mature Milker: 4 years old and up
- Lot 5 Dry Doe: any age (must have freshened at least once)
- Lot 6 Herd: 3 to 5 animals (Doe, Buck & Kid(s) Kids may be entered as Market Goat.

#### CLASS 5 MEAT BREED GOATS (Limit 3 per Lot)

Meat Breed goats may have horns IF their Breed requires for breed standards.

- Lot 1 Kid Doe: 1 12 months old
- Lot 2 Yearling Doe: over 1 year, under 2 years
- Lot 3 Aged Doe: 2 years and older
- Lot 4 Kid Buck: 1 12 months old
- Lot 5 Yearling Buck: 1 year to 2 years
- Lot 6 Aged Buck: 2 yrs and older
- Lot 7 Herd: 3 to 5 animals (Doe, Buck & Kid(s)) Kids may be entered as Market Goat.

#### **PACK GOATS**

#### **RULES FOR TRAIL CLASS:**

- Goats must carry weight in packs according to age and weight of the animal. Percentages are based on total weight of pack and weight carried. Under 1 yr: not less than 10% of body weight.
  - 1 2 yrs: not less than 15% of body weight
  - 2 yrs and over: not less than 20% of body weight

Handler to determine weight with regards to fitness of animal. Pack Goats will be weighed in at weigh-in at 8:00 AM Thursday, September 13, 2018.

Pack Saddle Weigh-in: Immediately before Pack show, prior to class.

- Pack goats must have a web type collar or halter with a lead
- No Market goats.
- May have horns if Breed Standard requires.

#### CLASS 6 PACK GOAT TRAIL CLASS (Limit 3 per Lot)

- Lot 1 Junior Handler
- Lot 2 Senior Handler
- Lot 3 String: 2 or more Pack Goats (Senior Members ONLY)

Exhibitors will be given a list of possible course obstacles to train for. Show course may contain any or all of listed obstacles.

- At the end of course, the judge may be checking pack saddle for fit.

You may be asked to remove saddle, and Judge will perform a simple exam of animal, and be judged on fitness and condition as a pack goat. - Animal to be lead with a loose lead. (Encouraging tugs at appropriate times)

# All swine must be watered with a nipple type water device (NO OPEN WATER CONTAINERS)

All swine should be ear tagged. It is the objective of the Swine Program to feed, care for, and train pigs for show and sale. Members are to be able to handle their animals both in and out of the show ring.

**ALL SWINE** must meet Arizona Department of Agriculture Psuedorabies Regulations for Import & Exhibition.

- Swine must be ear notched with the Universal Ear notch System. If they are not ear notched they must have Dept of Ag approved tag.
- Must have Premise ID number and/or USDA approved tag.
- Must have BILL OF SALE that includes ALL of the following:

Seller, buyer, date of sale, premise ID #, and/or USDA approved tag, Litter #, Individual #.

**OUT OF STATE SWINE** must originate from a stage 4 or 5 state to be eligible to show. Swine originating from a stage 4 state MUST be certified Psuedorabies negative prior to Swine tagging in June. See Extension Office for Complete regulations PRIOR to any out of state purchase.

#### CLASS 1 SWINE SHOWMANSHIP

Lot 1 Senior Showmanship Lot 2 Junior Showmanship

The exhibitor must show a market hog in the Showmanship Class unless the exhibitor only has breeder hogs at the Fair. In such case, the exhibitor will show younger of the breeding animals. NO BOARS will be shown in showmanship.

#### CLASS 2 MARKET SWINE (Barrows & Gilts ONLY)

Pigs should be 60 - 80 lbs, suggested starting weight.
Maximum start weight at beginning weigh in: 100 lbs
Minimum weight at Fair: 215 lbs, NO Max Weight
Pay limit: 275 lbs.

- Lot 1 Weight lots: light, medium and heavy, may be set by 4-H/FFA Fair Committee after all animals are weighed.
- Lot 2 Prospect Class: under 214 lbs
  Prospect classes are not Auction eligible.

#### CLASS 3 BREEDING SWINE

Market swine may not be shown in breeding classes except Lot 4.

- Lot 1 Sow and litter: shown in pen only
- Lot 2 Gilt: 6 to 12 months old
- Lot 3 Sow: over 12 months old
- Lot 4 Produce of sow: two (2) or more market hogs from litters farrowed by a sow that has been shown previously as a 4-H or FFA project at the Mohave County Fair. Sow and weaner pigs may be owned by different exhibitors. The owner of the sow will have the right to pick and choose at Fair time those hogs to be shown in this class.

Beef animals will be ear-tagged at the beginning of the project. **DAILY GAIN AWARDS** will be calculated based on official weigh-in February 10, 2018.

#### OFFICIAL SIFTING of Market Steers - May 5, 2018

ALL steers will be weighed in and complete a manageability sifting on official scale on May 5, 2018. A sifting committee will be on hand at scales and stall area to evaluate all steers on manageability. All members MUST be able to lead their steers to the scales, off the scales and stop their steer by themselves with absolutely no assistance. ANY steer found to be unmanageable and not meeting the sifting committee's final okay will be sifted from the project at that time. The same manageability requirements will be in force at the County Fair. Nose rings may NOT be used.

Only one entry of market stock, or a lot, can be sold through the auction by any one exhibitor. (See General Rules Auction) No bulls will be allowed in the auction, nor can they be shown in market classes. All steers must have been dehorned, may not be longer that 1" above hairline.

Suggested minimum weight of beef when purchased - 500 lbs., depending on breed and body type - but not mandatory.
