

Trick or Treat So Others Can Eat



Mid October to Early November

"Trick or Treat So Others Can Eat" is a door-to-door food drive sponsored by your local 4-H club in conjunction with 4-H members from across Maricopa County. If you wish to conduct a campaign in your neighborhood or community, here's what you'll need to do:

- Complete the registration (below) and return to the 4-H office. Indicate the general area (street names) that your group plans to cover. We want to be sure and not ask the same folks for donations twice.
- Call the local food bank or food pantry (if you aren't aware of one in your area, call the 4-H office) and let them know that your 4-H group will be going door-to-door collecting non-perishable foods for their food bank/pantry. Tell them that you will be doing this during the designated dates in the county 4-H calendar and when would be a convenient time to drop off your collection.
- 4-Hers should give a thank you note to each person who donates an item.
- Your group should be dressed in 4-H attire to collect food door-to-door and deliver it to the food bank. Then, submit the report form to the 4-H office and report how many youth and adults participated and how many pounds of food you collected.
- Other tips:
 - \checkmark You could call the local newspaper, radio or television and request that they cover this activity. Give them plenty of notice.
 - J Take lots of pictures! (Send one to the 4-H office.)
 - $\sqrt{1}$ If you know of other 4-H groups in your area, contact them and discuss conducting a joint activity.
