Cool weather crops

Lettuce, spinach, Swiss chard, endive, radish, beets, carrots, turnips, cole crops (cabbage, broccoli, cauliflower, Brussels sprouts, kale), peas, onion family, celery

- Like cool weather
- · Grow well in some shade
- Plant early
- Can tolerate some frost

Warm weather crops

Beans, tomatoes, peppers, eggplant, summer squash, winter squash, pumpkins, cucumbers, melons

- Like hot weather
- Grow best in full sun
- Plant late
- Killed by frost

Intermediate crops

Corn, potatoes

- Can tolerate some frost
- Plant slightly earlier than warm crops

Perennial crops

Asparagus, Jerusalem artichokes (sun chokes), rhubarb

- · Will winter over
- Can tolerate our weather
