


WHAT TO EXPECT – ARIZONA 4-H SUMMIT 2022

Lodging:

- □ Yuma Residence Hall, 1107 E James E Rogers Way, Tucson, AZ 85719
- □ Youth will be dropped off and picked up at this location
- Linens are not provided, so make sure to bring your own
- Drop off: Saturday, June 4 between 12:00 and 12:30 PM
- Pick up: Wednesday, June 8 at approximately 2:30 PM
- Dorm rooms and bathrooms are separated by gender, and each room has a sink

Parking:

- □ James E Rogers Way is one-way (east to west) and accessible from Mountain Ave.
- Free weekend parking near Yuma Residence Hall:



- □ Most spots are controlled M-F only, but check signs for each spot/lot to be sure
- □ Any parking space that is not controlled 24 hours is available for free for drop-off
- □ For pick-up, use 20-minute spots, metered spots, or risk a ticket in other spots
- □ Parking passes will be provided to participants who drive themselves
