

Arizona 4-H Consumer Decision Making Contest Rules

(This contest is a Qualifier for Western National Roundup)

This contest is based on the skills of consumer observation, comparison, and the ability to make a fact-based purchases.

Age Divisions:

Junior – 8-10 Years Old Intermediate – 11-13 Years Old Senior – 14-19 Years Old

Age Divisions will be determined by age as of 12/31/2019.

Only Seniors may qualify for Western National Roundup

Procedures:

- Six classes will be judged with four items in each class.
- Each class will consist of 4 items and a scenario. The contestant should determine the
 order to place the class from most appropriate to least appropriate and indicate their
 ranking on the score card.
- Cards must be marked with contestant number, class name and placing. Failure to mark either of these areas will result in a zero for that card.
- Total scores are based on 50 points each for 6 classes (300 points possible).
- Ties will be broken by the judges.

- Each Contestant will be awarded based on the Danish System. Blue Awards will be given to those who exceed expectations. Red Awards will be given to those who meet expectations. White Awards will be given to those who do not meet expectations.
