Water's Incredible Journey

Students learn about Earth's hydrologic cycle as they move through the water cycle, collecting beads representing places where water is located. Optional reading: *A Drop Around the World*.

Understanding Ground Water

Students learn how surface water & groundwater are connected, how the water table changes, & that groundwater is a finite resource.

Exploring Watersheds

Students learn what a watershed is & create a model to learn how water flows in a watershed & how land use can affect water quality. Colorado River Watershed extension activity available.

Water: Use and Conservation

Students learn about our water sources, how water is used & ways to conserve Earth's most precious resource.

Then & Now

Students learn about the accessibility & usage of water in the past versus now & how it affects people around the world.

Crack the Code Water Challenge

Students solve challenges to find codes to open locks while learning about Prescott's urban water cycle.

Students learn about careers related to the water we use.
