Dear Colleagues and Friends of NRULPC,

We end the year with great thanks to all of you for your support of the important work we are doing through the NRULPC and Clinic. Our recent virtual Advisory Board meeting on November 27<sup>th</sup> highlighted many of the projects staff and students are involved with (many suggested by a wide variety of our stakeholders). These projects are undertaken for the express purpose of increasing farmers, ranchers, small miners, landowners, and others understanding of regulatory hurdles associated with land use. While the Center and the Clinic are working on independent projects, most efforts have overlap and create synergy for the Clinic and its students. These cover a broad range of topics such as prescribed fires, water and land use rights, labor shortages, wolf reintroduction, and grazing allotments. Undergraduate classroom activities and coursework are also supported jointly. We especially thank those of you who have given your time to meet with students and provide them with your expertise. has a full contingent of new students for the spring semester, and the Center has a full docket of matters in progress.

These will all be reviewed carefully and taken into consideration as plans are made for an in-person Advisory Board meeting in March 2019.
